## DAY 1

*However, we possess this precious treasure [the divine Light of the Gospel] in [frail, human] vessels of earth, that the grandeur and exceeding greatness of the power may be shown to be from God and not from ourselves.  
2 Corinthians 4:7 AMP*

### **Observation:**

Though you are created a masterpiece by the Master himself, true life cannot flow through you if you are not connected to Him. This treasure is the resurrected life of Christ living in you and through you. Are you allowing this treasure to be released? You can become in reality much more than you are now. Saul never planned to be Paul. Joseph never planned to rule and be second to Pharaoh. You are capable of much more than you expect of yourself. "Unexpected dormant potential rests beneath the surface of your daily existence waiting to be discovered and released." Myles Munroe.

### **Application:**

I won't stop cultivating, developing, activating, releasing, depositing. There is a world out there waiting for the treasure and potential God has invested in me. What areas in my life can I focus on to cultivate, develop and release?

*Prayer* 

I surrender all to You my blessed Saviour, I surrender all. Thank You for the courage to develop and release the treasure in me as I lie like clay in Your hands.

## DAY 2

*Life and death are in the power of the tongue.  
Proverbs 18:21*

### **Observation:**

Your tongue is a weapon and a vehicle. It will take you wherever your thoughts direct it, pouring out either sweet or bitter water, life or death. What are you saying **to** yourself? What are you saying **about** yourself? Is it lining up with how God sees you, or with how your parents, teachers, friends, and critics see you? Whose report do you believe? You are the first prophet of your life. When a prophecy is given, it must line up with the Word of God and the character of God. Whatever you say becomes a pathway to your future.

### **Application:**

I take responsibility for my tongue and I will arrest myself every time I speak words that do not line up with how God sees me. I ask myself why I am saying this about myself and if this statement is really true. If it is untrue, how can I begin to line up with the truth based on God's word and embrace this truth?

### *Prayer*

I surrender my thoughts and words to You, Holy Spirit, and I ask that You flood me with your light to see how You see me and I embrace and love myself as You love me.

*Since we have the same spirit of faith according to what has been written, “I believed, and so I spoke,” we also believe, and so we also speak  
2 Corinthians 4:13 ESV*

**Observation:**

It takes faith to believe what God says about you and faith to speak it out. It is a spirit of faith — meaning it is not just a moment of enthusiasm but a lifestyle, a way of BEING. You are taught to live by faith and not by sight. Faith is your telescope to see what is in the heavenly realm, beyond our sphere. You need to live life looking at it from God's perspective, which is far higher than your own. Then you align with God's perspective by faith and trust in the Holy Spirit who does the work of regeneration in your BEING. You believe that there is no other Savior for mankind but Jesus, and you live your life accordingly. God says certain things about you; submit to His beliefs about you and embrace them, then speak them over your life. Shower your life with His words and His image of you, disregarding what circumstances, weaknesses, and failures say. The truth that remains is how HE SEES YOU, and upon that truth, you will build.

## DAY 3

### *Application:*

I speak His word over my life: Proverbs 3:5-6 I trust in the Lord with all my heart and I lean not on my own understanding. In all my ways I acknowledge Him and He shall direct my path.

Ephesians 6:10 - I am strong in the Lord and in His mighty power.

2 Chronicles 15:7 I will be strong and not give up, for my work will be rewarded.

### *Prayer*

I soak myself in the image You have of me Lord, and I arise to give You praise and glory for You ALONE are worthy. I honor You in all I am and in all I do. Thank You that You, Holy Spirit, are my guide, my helper and my strength so that I can always be pleasing to the Father.

**Observation:**

God has created you uniquely and put wonders in you that are beyond your understanding or imagination. God, therefore, knows your capacity and your limits. He knows the measure of your excellence. If you were a car and you were made to run like a Mercedes Benz 3000, you must not perform in life as though you were a Fiat Panda 1100, it is foolish to do that. Fiat Pandas are nice, but they are no comparison to a Mercedes Benz 3000.

Human nature will naturally lead you to compare yourself with others but instead, by looking at yourself through God's eyes, you will be able to see your true measure as He designed you to be and receive the strength and power to live life according to the excellence He put in you. Look to Jesus, not to your peers and their accomplishments, but focus on Him Who is the author and finisher of your faith.

## DAY 4

As you look to Him and focus on Him, you are stirring your faith to flow in the measure of excellence and capacity He has invested in you. He is able to do immeasurably more because He knows your ability, therefore, it is foolish to compare yourself with others or be daunted by others' accomplishments.

### *Application:*

I will stay focused on my assignment and take steps towards what I know to do.

As I do, the next steps will be revealed. More is revealed when I take action NOT when I pause.

### *Prayer*

I trust You to order my steps in the way that I should go. I trust You to help me step out courageously. I am safe in Your hands.

**In what ways have you been comparing yourself to others? How might this be limiting your recognition of the unique excellence God has placed within you?**

**What action could you take NOW to amend that?**

**Observation:**

Whether you serve in business, or your family, ministry or as a volunteer – do it with the strength He provides. He provides grace to do the work. His strength is His grace. Grace is the power of God upon flesh to do what flesh (or our own ability) cannot do without Him. Grace is the power that comes upon you during the storm or some challenge and envelopes you, lifting you high above the situation, giving you clarity, wisdom and direction to know what to do. God is the One who filled you with divine potential and wired you in a unique way to fulfill your call. It can only be done by His strength that draws out the potential He invested in you. It took courage for Peter to get out of his comfort zone and take the challenge. It took faith and trust in Jesus walking on the water. It took connecting to Jesus at that moment and immediately grace and strength was released to walk on water.

## DAY 5

### *Application:*

I will make time during the day to intentionally connect with heaven by taking ten and twenty minute breaks to soak in His grace as I go through my day.



Thank You for the grace and strength to live life intentionally – a life that is a worthy offering to You.

## DAY 6

*What is man that You are mindful of him, the son of man that You care for him?  
Psalm 8:4*

### **Observation:**

God invested in you generously. He has given you the ability to be and do all that he has planned and designed for you to do . He has secured you and fully provided all that you would ever need. He does not invest in failures. You have everything you need to go through a storm. When you think you can't, press on, knowing that He does not require what He has not provided for.

### **Application:**

I intentionally push when I think or feel I can't . What areas am I having difficulty handling? Is it a skill I need to learn? Or a characteristic I need to develop?

*Prayer* 

To God be the glory, great things He has done and I am one of them. Thank You for everything You have put in me.

## ***ALIGNMENT QUESTIONS***

**How can you change your thinking from “I can’t” to trusting that God has equipped you for the challenges you face?**

**What action could you take NOW to amend that?**

**What scripture will support your NOW action?**

## DAY 7

*And the angel of the Lord said to Manoah, let the mother beware of all that I told her. She may not eat of anything that comes from the grapevine nor drink wine or strong drink nor eat any unclean thing. All that I command her let her observe.  
Judges 13:13-14*

### **Observation:**

God had a plan for this child and He has a plan for every child. As always, God works in partnership with us when He wants to do a work on earth. God needed the mother's partnership to make the plan work. He gave her instructions of how to look after herself in order for the plan to work. Your well-being directly affects your children. You need to be mentally, emotionally, spiritually and physically fit as it has everything to do with your child's destiny. The value systems must work in your life first. You are the influencer, who you are shapes your child and his or her destiny. If you observe these values, it will be well with your child.

### **Application:**

What has God told me about my children? What word from God have I received? I commit to speak out the word of God and truth upon their lives. I will teach by example making His values our lifestyle.

## *Prayer*

Thank you Lord that I am your partner in shaping the life of my children and grandchildren. I am led of God and I hear His voice and I quickly respond to His direction.

## DAY 8

*But Jesus looked at them and said to them, “With men this is impossible, but with God all things are possible.”*

*Matthew 19:26*

### **Observation:**

God knows what He put in you. He put the God kind of potential with the God kind of faith in you. All it takes is for you to believe. Believing Him releases that which He put in you. He gives you the great ideas, but you need to believe in the ideas and commit yourself to doing them.

### **Application:**

I need to take the ideas and courageously begin to implement them.

*Prayer* 

Thank You, Lord, for the courage You poured into me. I commit to You my baby steps toward the big ideas and the desires You have given me.

## ***ALIGNMENT QUESTIONS***

**What big idea or dream has God placed in your heart that need to believe in more?**

**What action could you take NOW to commit yourself to making that idea a reality?**

**What scripture will support your NOW action?**

*You have everything

a storm.*

*For who has despised the day of small things?  
Zechariah 4:10*

*So Jesus said to them, "...for assuredly, I say to you, if you have faith as a mustard seed, you will say to this mountain, 'Move from here to there,' and it will move; and nothing will be impossible for you.*

*Matthew 17:20*

**Observation:**

Small must not be underestimated. Small actions are powerful actions. Whatever you do to bring great results – to bring about the impossible MUST start with SMALL actions. Brendon Burchard, author and coach said, "Never let your small beginnings make you small-minded."

Why will nothing be impossible for you? Because you have faith as small as a mustard seed that is powerful. Your small faith is so powerful that it will move a mountain that is bigger than you. Bigger than you can handle, beyond you. Put your faith to action as you step out, taking baby steps to bring about that which is impossible, but possible in God.

## DAY 9

### *Application:*

What is the mountain before me? Is it a skill I must learn, a difficult relationship, a project or business to launch? I will take faith-filled baby steps to accomplish what seems impossible.

### *Prayer*

Thank you Lord for equipping me with potential and faith to do what is impossible in my own sight. Your power working in me is able to carry out Your purpose for me and do superabundantly far above all that I dare ask, think or imagine - beyond my prayers, beyond my thoughts, imagination, hopes or dreams.

**What support or resource do you think you need to take the first small step?**

**What scripture will support your NOW action?**

## DAY 10

*I have strength for all things in Christ who empowers me (I am ready for anything and equal to anything through Him who infuses inner strength into me. I am self-sufficient in Christ's sufficiency)  
Philipians 4:13 AMP*

### **Observation:**

Whatever you are assigned to do, you have the strength to do it. You have strength for your assignment whether it is about relationships or areas of your purpose or vision. If you are assigned to it, you have the strength to do it. It is not a one-time strength when you feel weak or down. God 'infuses' inner strength. "Infuse" according to the Merriam-Webster dictionary means 1- to steep something in a liquid to extract the flavours from it - to soak 2: to inspire or fill with a certain quality. I can deal with all things - every challenge that comes my way because I am continually soaked, marinated in His strength in my inner man. You are self-sufficient in His sufficiency because you are infused in His strength. He infuses you with His ever-present presence.

### **Application:**

What areas am I too intimidated to deal with or too overwhelmed with? What action steps can I take?

*Prayer* 

Thank You, Lord, that as I come to You, You soak, marinate and infuse me with Your strength so that I am well able, inspired and stirred in my innermost being to take action in my assignments. You are truly my helper and strength.

## ***ALIGNMENT QUESTIONS***

**What challenge are you facing right now that you need to trust God to infuse you with strength to overcome?**

**What action could you take NOW to position yourself to be infused with strength to overcome?**

**What scripture will support your NOW action?**

## DAY 11

*...and (so that you will begin to know) what is the immeasurable and unlimited and surpassing greatness of His (active, spiritual) power is in us who believe. These are in accordance with the working of His mighty strength.  
Ephesians 1:19 AMP*

### **Observation:**

Verses 17 and 18 says that there is wisdom and revelation once the eyes of your heart are flooded with light and you will know and understand that you are called to a living hope and that your inheritance is glorious. Verse 19 tells you that you can live this great life NOW because there is unlimited power in you. His power is in you as He infuses you with His strength. Soaked in His strength! Are the eyes of your heart flooded with light so you can see beyond the natural realm? God has wired you to produce everything He expects. God never gives you a responsibility without giving you the ability and authority to carry it out. He has already innately provided for that which He demands of you. The question is – how much of His power am I using?

### **Application:**

I will make a list of those things that seem ‘impossible’ ‘difficult’ and focus on His ability working in me and begin to get unstuck.

*Prayer* 

You never leave me or forsake me Lord! Thank You for working in me, thank You for sending me help so I can get unstuck. Help me not to limit Your strength in me.

## ***ALIGNMENT QUESTIONS***

**What areas of your life do you feel you are not fully tapping into God's power within you to live a life that reflects His greatness?**

**What action could you take NOW to amend that?**

**What scripture will support your NOW action?**

## DAY 12

*And God is able to make all grace (every favor and earthly blessing) come in abundance to you, so that you may always (under all circumstances, regardless of the need) have complete sufficiency in everything (being completely self-sufficient in Him) and have an abundance for every good work and act of charity.*

*2 Corinthians 9:8 AMP*

### **Observation:**

God has a good work prepared for you and me. A work that your unique self, with all the potential He has invested in you is designed to do. A good work. The world needs what you have, and earth is crying out for your gifts and potential to pour out.

### **Application:**

I must give my potential some responsibility, the responsibility to show up strong for the work at hand. How? I work on polishing my gifting. I activate the gift to serve people. I will think, create, pray.

## *Prayer*

I surrender to you. I will not let my ego talk me out of who I am in You. I refuse to submit to my selfish self that is limiting me. I choose to arise and shine Your truth. I am full of grace, God-sufficient in all circumstances.

## ***ALIGNMENT QUESTIONS***

**What is one area of your life where you are using your unique gifts to serve others?**

**What action could you take NOW to improve that?**

## DAY 13

*I have told you these things so that in me you may have (perfect) peace. In the world you have tribulation and distress and suffering but be courageous (be confident, be undaunted, be filled with joy); I have overcome the world". (My conquest is accomplished, my victory abiding)  
John 16:33 AMP*

### **Observation:**

My certainty, courage and confidence is in Him who conquered and overcame the world. He who has equipped me to overcome, gives peace. He has filled me with enough potential to overcome the odds, the troubles that come my way. Not only has He already overcome, but He has also equipped me to know how to overcome strategically with total peace.

### **Application:**

I expect direction and wisdom to flow out as I completely put my trust in Him Who has already overcome. I will beat the odds; I won't allow myself to be paralysed because of trouble that surrounds me. Action plan: I will declare His word over my life. I will declare it creatively - draw it, paint it, write it, sing it

## *Prayer*

Thank you, Lord, that I can lean on You knowing that You are my confidence and peace. You lift me up, and I stand on the truth of Your word. You have overcome the world for me, therefore it has no power over me. Thank You for divine wisdom and direction at all times.

## ***ALIGNMENT QUESTIONS***

**What is one way you can trust God's strength to help you overcome a current struggle?**

**What action could you take NOW towards that?**

**What scripture will support your NOW action?**

*God is looking for  
your availability not  
your accomplishments.*

*Then Saul clothed David with his armor. He put a helmet of bronze on his head and clothed him with a coat of mail, and David strapped his sword over his armor. And he tried in vain to go, for he had not tested them. Then David said to Saul, "I cannot go with these, for I have not tested them." So David put them off.  
1 Samuel 17:38-39 ESV*

**Observation:**

People want you to identify with God according to their own experience. David's relationship with God was not similar to Saul's relationship with God. Saul's talents and style and tools were different to David's. David recognized that, though Saul's armour and sword were excellent, he was not familiar with them. People will want to fit you into a system that works for them, but it does not necessarily mean it will work for you. These tools were inappropriate for David. It was necessary for David to take up a tool he knew well and was skillful in using. He was skillful with a sling and stone. David's sling was no match for King Saul's sword and armor which were state-of-the-art weaponry, but David knew he would not experience victory using Saul's tools.

## DAY 14

### *Application:*

I must train myself to use tools with which I can win battles. Becoming skillful with my tools plus God's anointing equals victory. The tool does not guarantee my success, but the anointing on me, God in me, is the guarantee with signs and wonders following. Tools help me help people effectively.

### *Prayer*

Father, help me to recognize the tools You have put in my hands, teach me to be skillful so that Your signs and wonders can manifest.

## ***ALIGNMENT QUESTIONS***

**Are there any expectations others have of you that don't align with your strengths or calling?**

**What action could you take NOW to amend that?**

**What scripture will support your NOW action?**

## DAY 15

*For I know the plans I have for you, declares the Lord, plans for welfare and not for evil, to give you a future and a hope.  
Jeremiah 29:11 ESV*

### **Observation:**

God will not tell you to do something that He has not already paid for and provided for. His plans also include the tools you need to fulfill them. The good future He has for you is a possible future. He has invested in you and me every potential, strength and power needed for a glorious future. He believes in His plan for you, the question is, do you believe in His plan for you? If you can conceive an idea then you can carry it out, because He has given you the potential to make it a reality.

### **Application:**

I refuse to allow my limiting beliefs to stop me from taking action.  
Action plan: Envision it, write it, create a plan, then schedule it.

## *Prayer*

Thank You, Lord, for Your good plan. I commit to Your plan.  
Thank You for enlightening me to see what You see. Thank You for the strength and wisdom to take action.

## ***ALIGNMENT QUESTIONS***

**How can you begin to believe in the plans God has for your future?**

**What action could you take NOW to move closer to fulfilling God's plan for you?**

**What scripture will support your NOW action?**

## DAY 16

*For to everyone who has will more be given, and he will have an abundance. But from the one who has not, even what he has will be taken away.*  
*Matthew 25:29 ESV*

### **Observation:**

You are accountable to God for the wealth of your resources. You are responsible to discover, enhance and cultivate all that you have received from God. God watches you carefully to see how you use or abuse these resources.

### **Application:**

Do I know my talents, gifts? How am I using the wealth of time, money, and skills I am given?

## *Prayer*

Help me, Lord, be fruitful and pleasing to you. My desire is for You to find pleasure as I honour You by taking care of and putting to good use what You have already given me. Open my eyes to the things that I already have, yet I am unable to see.

## ***ALIGNMENT QUESTIONS***

**What resources (time, talent, energy) have you been neglecting that God has given you to invest wisely?**

**What action could you take NOW to amend that?**

**What scripture will support your NOW action?**

## DAY 17

*Also, every man to whom God has given riches and possessions, and the power to enjoy them and to accept his appointed lot and to rejoice in his toil—this is the gift of God [to him].*

*Ecclesiastes 5:19 AMP*

### **Observation:**

Thomas Edison said “Genius is 10 % inspiration and 90% perspiration” Don’t allow the pain and perspiration of work hide the blessing it can give. Work does not exist because of sin but rather, sin changed the condition of work. Genesis 3:17-19 Cursed is the ground....through painful toil you will eat of it...it will produce thorns and thistles...by the sweat of your brow you will eat your food.

### **Application:**

I will work hard because the conditions demand it. I will do so by mastering the necessary technology and knowledge I need, one at a time. I choose to work in joy and faith for God delights in a good attitude and because Jesus became poor that I might be rich. I choose to work for His glory and my victory.

*Prayer* 

I put my trust in You and the abundant grace You have placed in me. I choose to work diligently with discipline.

## DAY 18

*In the morning sow your seed, and in the evening do not withhold your hand; For you do not know which will prosper, either this or that, or whether both alike will be good.*

*Ecclesiastes 11:6 NKJ*

### **Observation:**

God encourages hard work. Don't stay idle. Work keeps you productive and creative. Work is sowing seed, taking bold steps and risks. There is no retirement plan with God. You can retire from a particular job but never from our purpose. God designed you to fulfill your purpose on earth, using your potential which will have an eternal impact. You have an immortal spirit with an eternal purpose therefore you will forever be busy working to fulfill His plans.

### **Application:**

Learn to transition from one job or assignment to another, but never with the plan to retire.

## *Prayer*

Help me, Lord, to walk in Your plans for me. I refuse to 'retire' from any assignment before time. I fulfill all that You have planned for me till the end of my life on earth. I live intentionally for Your praise and glory.

## DAY 19

*Blessed is everyone who fears the LORD, who walks in his ways!*

*You shall eat the fruit of the labor of your hands; you shall be blessed, and it shall be well with you.*

*Psalm 128:1-2 ESV*

### **Observation:**

“Work is God’s way to draw out your potential” Myles Munroe. Any work is an instrument that will cause you, if you choose, to grow and be productive. Even if you are working a job you don’t like, if you choose to, you will become productive in some area of your life. Work is a way to get some personal gratification. God gave Adam work in Eden to draw out his creativity and exercise his authority over the animals and plants. Work keeps you productive and healthy, mentally and emotionally.

### **Application:**

Always keep working and creating whether it is learning a skill, writing an article or exercising. Work is God’s way of drawing out the potential within.

## *Prayer*

Thank You, Lord, for the gift of working and producing. Thank You that You have empowered me to bear good fruit. I will eat the fruit of my labour. Blessings and prosperity are mine.

## DAY 20

*He who is slothful in his work is a brother to him who is a great destroyer. Slack habits and sloppy work are as bad as vandalism (The Message)  
Proverbs 18:9 NKJ*

### **Observation:**

Slack means loose, limp, decrease or reduce in intensity, quantity or speed. If it was in a work context, it would mean no focus, no stability or speed resulting in failure. There is no promotion without taking responsibility and hard working. Jesus needs you to be a diligent smart worker who is focused, flexible, willing and growing in skill and knowledge. The world needs what God has invested in you. God is the only guarantee for success if you work. God wants you to work so you can see what you can do with the ability, gifts and potential he has invested in you.

### **Application:**

I explore to discover what areas I find myself slack in. I design the steps to take in my career, ministry, soul and body so that I am not slack or falling behind. I will reconnect with my accountability partner and go over my goals and refresh or adjust where necessary.

### *Prayer*

I step into Your strength Lord. I soak myself in Your goodness and kindness for Your banner over me is love. Thank You for enlightening me to know what needs to be tightened, stabilized and focused.

**What action could you take NOW to cultivate more focus and diligence so as to reflect your potential?**

## DAY 21

*And on the seventh day God finished his work that he had done, and he rested on the seventh day from all his work that he had done. So God blessed the seventh day and made it holy, because on it God rested from all his work that he had done in creation.*

*Genesis 2:2-3*

### **Observation:**

God brought out and created what was in Him and then rested. He worked, without working God would not have brought out the invisible which was in Him into manifestation. If God had not worked and brought the universe out, it would have remained within Him. God took time off after His hard work and rested. Taking time off to rest is a holy thing. Work without rest is unproductive, it is just busy. Whereas work with time to rest allows you to be refreshed. God takes resting time seriously.

### **Application:**

To guarantee great productivity, I must take time to reflect on God's goodness in my life throughout the week as I work. It is a time to note my wins, giving Him thanks and evaluating how else I can become sharper and more productive.

## *Prayer*

I choose to honor and emulate You by taking a day of rest and treat it as 'holy'. Teach me how to create a day of rest that praises You and that fulfills me physically, mentally and emotionally.

## DAY 22

God had a vision of what He wanted to create, He did not imagine it into manifestation nor did it remain a dream within Him. He created it by working. He envisioned it in detail and spoke it into existence. Speaking is working. It is necessary to pause and give praise to God for your own good work. It is not pride, but true humility when you recognize that your excellent work comes from your God given potential He invested in you. Humility is recognizing that you were faithful to put your gifts to work and seeing them bear good fruit. We need to take time to evaluate our work, as God did.

### **Application:**

Help me, Holy Spirit, to draw out from You strength and courage to establish habits that will help me live life one step at a time, one moment at a time, one day at a time.

## DAY 24

Poverty is not a matter of whether you have money or not but rather your mindset. God has given man the innate gift of creativity. “God gives ideas, schemes, concepts and projects.” M. Munroe. How we manage this creativity is the path from poverty to wealth. It takes diligence, time and commitment to build skills. Actually, poverty is a lack of creativity.

### **Application:**

I will not underestimate the fact that my skills will attract kings. I will work and build on my skills by putting a demand of excellence on all I do.

## *Prayer*

Lord, my God, help me see that underestimating myself is not honouring to You. Lacking momentum and energy is not honoring You, but rising up to be the masterpiece You have created me to be is an act of worship to Your magnificence. Not rising up is allowing poverty to reign. I choose to rise even in the midst of my weakness.

"Your job is your skill that they can fire you from at any time. But your work is your gift. No one can take that from you " M.Munroe. Working on your gift, working on releasing what sparks joy and energy is what the world needs and is the answer to poverty.

I will work on producing what I know I can create. Pursue and build what brings me joy.

Diligent comes from the latin word diligere, which means to “value highly, take delight in” (vocabulary.com) Not only are you careful and hard-working, but more importantly you value the work you do and enjoy it. Once you value and delight in your work, you become competent and in time, an authority in that particular field. It is the quality of work that you put in your giftings that will bring you before great people, causing you to become the head and not the tail. Father God was committed to His work and so was Jesus – John 5:7 (AMP) “But Jesus answered them, My Father has worked [even] until now, [He has never ceased working; He is still working] and I, too, must be at [divine] work.” Working diligently gives you the opportunity to bring out your best self.

### **Application:**

I intentionally commit to my work so that I can increase and improve the quality I am presenting. I lean on the Holy Spirit when I feel stuck and overwhelmed.

### *Prayer*

In You alone is my strength. I thank You for divine wisdom and courage to work beyond my ability where I will see Your grace perform what I naturally would not be able to accomplish.

No matter how much you may dislike a job, it will teach you discipline and diligence. Your work bears fruit when it is done in faith. As verse 26 says, "For as the body without the spirit is dead, so faith without works is dead also."

## DAY 27

Not by might nor by power BUT by Your Spirit, Lord, the spirit of faith. Thank You that I have ears to hear clearly and a will to obey quickly. I have the courage to step out in faith knowing You will provide and make a way where there seems to be no way.

Jesus alone is doing the work you cannot do. He predestined, appointed, and gave you right-standing with God. He called you to walk in a way that allows Him to glorify you. Your faults and shortcomings are not an issue for Him because He did not call you to walk in your own strength or achievements. Instead, He called you to step into His strength when you are weak. Entering His strength means humbling yourself and surrendering your thoughts, ideas, and methods to Him. He has already appointed, assigned, and guaranteed success. He is looking for your availability, not your accomplishments.

### **Application:**

I choose to humble myself and trust Him when I have to be flexible and make necessary changes. He is my guaranteed success, and I am in Him. I am committed to working hard and well as I develop new skills.

## *Prayer*

Help me, Lord, to be kind to myself and walk in joy in the midst of my imperfection. Help me to mature, and equip me with the mindset needed to bring You glory.

## ***ALIGNMENT QUESTIONS***

**In what situations have you relied solely on your own strength and felt inadequate, and how can surrendering to God's strength make a difference?**

**What action could you take NOW to amend that?**

**What scripture will support your NOW action?**

*You did not choose me, but I chose you and appointed you that you should go and bear fruit and that your fruit should abide, so that whatever you ask the Father in my name, he may give it to you.*

**Observation:**

You have chosen the Lord. No matter what you say to yourself, the guilt trips, the condescending attitude you may have towards yourself, the “not good enough, not excellent, just average” voices, Jesus still intentionally chose you! He chose you with all your flaws. He chose you and gave you an assignment. He believes in you more than you believe in yourself. It takes looking into the eyes of His love and allowing yourself to melt in the ocean of His love to be able to accept yourself. You must lay aside and burn out of existence, the negative image of yourself caused by the surrounding culture, home environment and relationships. Choose to grow in how He sees you, to embrace that image and make it your own. No affirmation, therapy, coaching or counseling can do that. They are only helpful guides based on scientific knowledge. Walking in intimacy with Christ, is what will establish you in your true identity and purpose.

## DAY 42

### *Application:*

I intentionally choose to see, embrace and own my significance in Him. I walk daily in intimacy with Christ, my Lord, and my days are lived with intention.

### *Prayer*

Lord, thank You, for helping me be the person You see me, physically, mentally and emotionally. Help me fulfill my assignment in a way that will make You proud of me.

**Observation:**

Whatever God does, He does with purpose. He does not make mistakes. He is a perfect God. There is no shadow of change in Him. When He places a gift and call on you, He does it with a purpose. You may not want to embrace them, and you may be afraid or ignorant of the call and gift, but they are there. They are treasures and not reversible. You do not want to die with your gift and calling still in a box, never opened, never used, always feeling and needing something more, never knowing what it is and being frustrated. You can rise up and refuse to be blown around by every wind of 'needs' 'musts' 'don'ts' and 'what ifs'. Instead, stop and take time to look within and see what He has deposited in you, then turn your eyes to His throne above and connect with heaven. There is more to you than you really know.

## DAY 43

### *Application:*

I will explore and discover my gift and calling and begin to refine them. I can do that by educating myself. I can take action and start doing what I think might be something I am good at, and believe God to light my way. If I ignore my gift and calling for whatever reason, then I am being irresponsible.

### *Prayer*

Thank you, Lord, for the gift and calling on my life. I pray You bring me before people that will help refine me so I can bring You pleasure as I fulfill the call.

## DAY 44

*...and they were astonished at his teaching, for his word possessed authority.*  
*Luke 4:32 ESV*

### **Observation:**

The scribes represent religious standards, law and order – the ‘musts’ and the ‘do nots’. Jesus was led by God’s purpose, not by a religious system or standard. His purpose and vision were clear: to heal the sick and brokenhearted and bring good news to the poor. According to religious standards, He was not ‘qualified’ to do all that He did; He was too young, unknown, untrained. But Jesus was anointed by God with purpose and vision, and signs and wonders followed Him. He had authority. Any established religious system can become idolatry. As Marshawn Evans Daniels says, “Your authority doesn’t come from man, paved paths and predictable plans; it comes from the King of Kings” The anointing, the Holy Spirit, is unlimited.

### **Application:**

I will pursue my growth in Christ. Without growth, there is no fruit. My tender relationship with Christ is 24 hours a day, 7 days a week—not just at a set time. However, having a set time is a helpful structure that keeps me on the right track and helps me build a good habit.

### *Prayer*

Open the eyes of my understanding that I might see your vision for me for you are the chief commander.

## DAY 45

*And Moses said, "I will turn aside to see this great sight, why the bush is not burned."  
Exodus 3:3 ESV*

### **Observation:**

Curiosity is what led Moses to the burning bush. God wants you to be curious too. He needs you to be curious about what's burning deep inside you. The enemy's job is to make you live in fear and ignorance of the still small voice deep down that calls you to your purpose and significance. This way, the devil tries to ensure that you live far beneath your birthright. Curiosity can create a strong desire to know more about what God has for you, it is the secret to shifting yourself to a higher purpose where you can explore, discover and understand more of what He has invested in you. Becoming bold is a learning process.

### **Application:**

I choose to pursue a bold curiosity while listening to His voice. What is it that I am afraid of exploring? I will dare to believe, embrace and dare to jump, swim and climb. How will I do this? I will get hold of His instructions, directions and write them down. I will look at them daily and find practical steps that move me towards their fulfillment.

### *Prayer*

My Lord, my King, I humble myself and bow before Your holy call and worship You. I thank You for my call and my specific assignment.

**Observation:**

The mother eagle stirs the nest, creating discomfort for her eaglets, forcing them out of their comfort zone. At first, they may feel as if they are in pain, or that their mother is being unkind. Yet without this stirring, they would never take that first step to spread their wings and learn to fly. Without using your wings, you will never know the heights you are meant to reach.

Finding your wings requires courage and a willingness to step out, even when fear looms. But God hasn't left you to discover them alone. He is faithfully watching over you, spreading His wings to carry you when you've gone as far as you can on your own. As Myles Munroe said, "The greatest gift God can offer is to push you into a crisis of temporary discomfort that demands you to try your wings."

## DAY 46

### *Application:*

I will intentionally choose how I respond to unexpected situations that show up in my life . Events + Response = Outcome. Will I choose to respond with wisdom and courage?

### *Prayer*

I am Your child and You have already filled me with courage, thus fear has no hold on me. You have given me your power, sound mind and love. Help me, Lord, to draw out all that You have invested in me so I can live a life worthy of You, worthy of Your sacrifice.

## ***ALIGNMENT QUESTIONS***

**What practical steps can you take to spread your wings and step out in faith, even if it feels uncomfortable?**

**What action could you take NOW to amend that?**

**What scripture will support your NOW action?**

*Envision it,  
write it,  
create a plan,  
schedule the plan.*

*For you did not receive the spirit of bondage again to fear, but you received the Spirit of adoption by whom we cry out, “Abba, Father.”*  
*Romans 8:15 NKJ*

**Observation:**

Fear is one of the greatest enemies of potential, but it can be useful when understood. Fear protects us from real danger, like keeping us from crossing a busy road carelessly or touching fire. However, when fear is left unchecked, it can hold you back from reaching your highest potential. It whispers, “things are impossible”, “you are too weak, unqualified, and incapable.”

But faith gives you a truer perspective. It grounds you in the reality of who you are, pointing you back to the One who knows you best—God, your Creator. Only He truly understands your capabilities and which limits you can overcome. You were created to thrive, not by relying on yourself or the world around you, but by staying connected to the One Who made you. Your highest potential is unlocked when you walk in alignment with Him. When you do, your life will not only reach its fullest expression, but will also impact the world around you.

## DAY 47

### *Application:*

I must intentionally be rooted and grounded in Him by daily spending quality time in His Word, giving ample time to LISTEN.

### *Prayer*

Thank You, Holy Spirit, for building me, shaping me and using how I respond to life as a way of drawing out the girl of “Your dreams” the girl You envisioned.

### **Observation:**

When you discover that you have a desire, it is often tied to your purpose—don't ignore it, explore it. Talk to the Holy Spirit about it. Ask yourself, "How deep is this desire?" If it's shallow, it will fade away with the first distraction. But if it's deep, it will stay with you, even after many years. Desire is like a seedling, water it with prayer. God honors serious committed hearts, so make sure what you desire is not just a wish, but is deeper than a wish.

### **There is a process before your desire matures:**

1. Water the desire by praying in the Holy Spirit. Explore it deeply with His guidance. Is this desire surface-level or does it have roots?
2. Use your God-given ability to imagine yourself in that fulfilled desire. Think big and bold—fall in love with the vision, and let faith rise within you.
3. Imagine it materializing. Give it structure in your mind, as though it's already real.
4. As the Holy Spirit guides you, ask and believe that you have already received it even before it's visible.
5. Expect your desire to be fulfilled. Set goals, take small steps, and prepare to receive what God has in store for you.

Each step draws you closer to your God-given purpose. Trust the process, and walk with the Holy Spirit every step of the way.

## DAY 48

### *Application:*

Imagine my God-centered vision and walk through it by faith and keep it before me daily.

### *Prayer*

Guide me Holy Spirit to see what Father sees. I embrace His thoughts and will and make them mine.

## DAY 49

God calls you to live from the perspective of the unseen. When you have a vision centered on Him, you don't need to have all the details figured out. You can set your goals without worrying about things you can't control or foresee. It requires a willingness to embrace the unknown and the mess, trusting fully in God's goodness and care. His love for you is unconditional—complete and without reservation. His steadfast love is more than enough to sustain and empower you as you move forward. Worrying about the future will not keep you in the zone of faith, believe and trust that God has already gone before you. Focus on today, win today and trust God for tomorrow.

### **Application:**

I choose to be faithful and committed to today and though I may have planned for tomorrow, I choose to lean on Him tomorrow to guide me. I refuse to worry about things I cannot control.

*Prayer* 

I lean not to my own understanding, but in all my ways I acknowledge You.

These thoughts are heavy with discouragement, fear, paralysis, and self-doubt, keeping you from shining your light and stepping into your full potential. These negative thoughts create a mental picture—an imagination that becomes tied to your emotions, making defeat feel real even before it happens.

The only way to tear down these false images is through the Word of God. His truth exposes the enemy's lies, allowing you to build the image God has of you. The Israelites saw themselves as grasshoppers in the Promised Land, not knowing the Canaanites were actually afraid of them because they had heard how God was with them. We too can underestimate ourselves when we forget who God says we are. Let His Word shape your thoughts, your vision, and your future.

## DAY 50

### *Application:*

I will consider my thoughts. I watch my words and adjust, quickly deleting doubt and fears. My words carry the power of life and death.

### *Prayer*

Holy Spirit, I submit my heart, ears and tongue to You so that I can align myself to what You see for me.

From her perspective, Mary was just chatting with Jesus while she carried the weight of the tasks alone. To Martha, it seemed as if Mary was wasting time. Frustrated, she turned to Jesus, expecting Him, as the Master, to understand her situation and set Mary straight.

But Jesus didn’t address Mary’s actions; He focused on Martha’s heart. He saw her overwhelmed and frustrated. He didn’t criticize her for being busy, organized, or driven. Instead, He lovingly pointed out that what she was consumed with, while not wrong, was not the most important thing. He was showing Martha that Mary had chosen to invest in something far greater—her relationship with Jesus, which was life-giving.

While work, business, and even ministry can rise and fall, who you are, your identity and purpose, remain. It’s that inner life, the foundation built by sitting at Jesus’ feet, that can never be taken from you. And it is that foundation that will enable you to build again, whether it’s a career, a business, or a ministry. Jesus was inviting Martha—and all of us—to make this our priority: investing in what is eternal.

## DAY 51

### *Application:*

Make my devotional time non-negotiable and consistent. My devotional time is my intimate time with the Lord. It is the place of growth, surgery, restoration, healing, rest and building.



Holy Spirit, help me to find a rhythm in my everyday life so that my devotional time is never missed.

I seek to grow in the art of being still by practicing it consistently.

I deeply desire and thirst for You. Teach me how to pursue You.

## DAY 53
